- Student will present, every Friday of Spanish class, a news article related to international news (preferably of a Spanish country)
- Student will bring a printed version of the article
- Student will have a minute (timed) to present the article to her/his peers

Grading:

- 5 points for bringing the news article
 - o Article must have a minimum length of 2 well developed paragraphs
- 10 points for presentation
 - o Information well communicated
 - o Addressing the audience speaking clearly
 - o Time management
