# Present Tense of “-go” Verbs

- The Present Tense “yo” form of several verbs ends in “-go.”

# Present Tense of “-go” Verbs

- caer – to fall → **caigo**
- hacer – to do/make → **hago**
- poner – to put → **pongo**
- salir- to leave/go out →  
**salgo**
- traer – to bring → **traigo**

poner – to put, to place

# Present Tense of “-go” Verbs

- **decir**-to say/tell → **digo** (e→i)
- **oír**- to hear → **oigo** (very irreg.)
- **tener**-to have → **tengo** (e→ie)
- **venir** —to come → **vengo** (e→ie)
-  **These verbs have other irregular issues as well.**

## Present Tense of “-cer/-cir” Verbs

- Many verbs that end in “-cer / -cir” have a present tense “yo” form that ends in “-zco.”
- c → zco
- The rest of the verbs are regular.

## Present Tense of “-cer/-cir” Verbs

- **conocer** –to know → **conozco**
- **conducir**-to drive → **conduzco**
- **obedecer**-to obey → **obedezco**
- **ofrecer**- to offer → **ofrezco**
- **pertenecer**-to belong → **pertenezco**
- **producir**-to produce → **produzco**
- **traducir**- to translate → **traduzco**

# Present Tense of “-ger/-gir” Verbs

- In verbs that end in “-ger / -gir” the “g” changes to a “j” in the yo form.
- g → j
- The rest of the verbs are regular.

## Present Tense of “-ger/-gir” Verbs

- **dirigir – to direct → dirijo**
- **escoger – to choose → escojo**
- **proteger- to protect → protejo**
- **recoger- to pick up → recojo**
- **for pronunciation reasons so you don't say “recogo”**

## More Irregular “yo” forms

- Some verbs have irregular “yo” forms.
- **dar – to give → doy**
- **saber- to know → sé**
- **ver- to see → veo**
- The rest of the verb forms are regular.



# More Irregular Verbs

- Some verbs are completely irregular in all forms.
- **ser- to be**
- **estar – to be**
- **ir- to go**
